

National Wildlife Protection Award

Nomination Criteria

General conditions

Must be a Vietnamese national and reside in Vietnam.

Notes

For the purpose of these awards, wildlife protection is defined as efforts directly relating to stopping illegal hunting and trade of wildlife.

The award aims at finding “non-business as usual” examples from enforcement officers/agencies, judges and prosecutors in the fight against illegal wildlife trade.

Period of recognition: **From 2015 – end of 2018**

INDIVIDUAL

Category 1: Outstanding Enforcement Officer Award

Applicable: Police officer, Forest Ranger, Fisheries Officer, Customs Officer, Border Guard Officer and other law enforcement.

Through his/her work, the candidate has greatly contributed to efforts to combat wildlife crime in **one or more** of the following ways:

- Protect wildlife in its habitat: The candidate has played an active role in the protection of wildlife within its habitat.
- Investigation: The candidate has led or played an active role in an in-depth investigation focusing on major criminal aspects of the wildlife trade (police only).
- Enforcement: The candidate has demonstrated excellence in his/her work, and commitment within their agency to combat illegal wildlife trade. Such commitment includes making arrests, interdicting smuggling and trade operations, efforts to address consumer demand, monitoring and management of wildlife farms, preventing transnational wildlife crime, etc.

Category 2: Outstanding Judge Award

- Candidate must be the one who directly tried wildlife crime case(s) resulting in imprisonment for offenders pursuant to the Penal Code and showing determination of the candidate in combating illegal wildlife trade.
- The verdict (s) have not been annulled by the appellate court.
- The issued verdict(s) have positively impacted the judiciary system, strengthen their views on the seriousness of wildlife crime.

Category 3: Prosecutor Award

- Handle cases after receiving case files from the Police.

- Giving properly recommendations for the settlement of the case since the beginning of the procedure.
- Give strong and convincing evidences in court, showing deep understanding of the case and determination in combating illegal wildlife trade.
- Action of the candidate must result in imprisonment for offender(s).

AGENCY

Outstanding Enforcement Agency Award

- Having consecutive arrests and prosecutions of wildlife criminals as the results of efforts by relevant officials within the agency.
- Extend investigations to arrest and prosecute leaders of criminal networks rather than just catching mules, transporters and middle men.
- Organizing activities relating wildlife protection and conservation such as training programs for officials to build capacity in combating wildlife crime.

Individual(s) or agency(s)

Kingpin Award

- Efforts undertaken by this exceptional individual or group of individuals and/or their agencies is determined to have had the greatest impact on wildlife protection to date, globally
